



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**COTTAGE ROAD, RAMSGATE**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

**To allow telecoms ducting and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Cottage Road, Ramsgate.**

**A closure is currently planned from Monday 10 August 2020 with estimated completion by 21 August 2020.**

**Cottage Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with B2054 Wellington Crescent.**

**Access to the remainder of Cottage Road continues from Abbots Hill direction**

**The alternative route for any through traffic is B2054 Wellington Crescent, Plains of Waterloo, La Belle Alliance Square, Camden Square, Camden Road and Abbots Hill**

**Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.**
