Crescent Road, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility repair and maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Crescent Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned between 08:00 hours and 18:00 hours from 14th February 2022, with estimated completion by 25th February 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ003SWAT11621473-01 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

Crescent Road will be closed in the vicinity of number 46, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility repair and maintenance works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Crescent Road, Vale Road, Grange Road and vice versa.
