**CRESCENT ROAD & VALE ROAD,
RAMSGATE**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow telecoms ducting and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Crescent Road and Vale Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 20 April 2020, with completion now estimated by 7 May 2020.

CRESCENT ROAD will be closed between the junctions with Vale Square and Codrington Road, to the extent indicated at any time on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via West Cliff Road and Grange Road

VALE ROAD will be closed at the junction with Crescent Road, with local access to the remainder of road continuing via Grange Road

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.

There is a chance that the planned dates may change, and updated information can be found on one.network – [BT Openreach Permit BC005MU1WSEP00WAQAGU5E04], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
