EAGLE HILL, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow demolition works and construction of new dwellings to be safely carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Eagle Hill, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from Wednesday 15 April 2020 for a duration currently estimated at up to 6 months.

Eagle Hill will be closed southwards from the junction with Chatham Street to the actual extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Access remains from High Street direction and the alternative route for any through traffic is via Chatham Street and High Street.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

There is a chance that the planned dates may change, and updated information can be found on one.network with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
