**EFFINGHAM STREET, RAMSGATE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2020**

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Effingham Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 1 February 2021 for up to 3 days. These works have been re-scheduled as a result of over-running works nearby.

Effingham Street will be closed in the general vicinity of numbers 17 to 21, to the actual extent indicated on site.

The alternative routes for through traffic are  
*Northbound* via Queen Street, Elms Avenue, Cannon Road, High Street and George Street  
*Southbound* via George Street, High Street, Chapel Place, Elms Avenue and Queen Street

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
