**Effingham Street, Ramsgate**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Effingham Street, Ramsgate.

Closures are planned from 4th April 2022, with estimated completion by 6th May 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (KZ50076580637-02 - UK Power Networks). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The works will be carried out in phases, where the road will be re-opened when operatives and deliveries are not present on site.

Effingham Street will be closed between number 17 and the junction of Queen Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility works are undertaken by UK Power Networks.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Queen Street, Elms Avenue, Cannon Road, High Street, George Street, Effingham Street, and vice versa.
