(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow for a crane to be placed on the highway, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Effingham Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned between 09:00hrs and 15:00hrs from 9th December 2021, with estimated completion by 9th December 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE10075270476-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

Effingham Street will be closed between numbers 2 and 6.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Effingham Street, George Street, High Street, Cannon Road, Elms Avenue, Queen Street and vice versa.
