EFFINGHAM STREET, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to provide new electricity supplies, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Effingham Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Tuesday 29 September 2020, with estimated completion by 12 October 2020.

Effingham Street will be closed in the general vicinity of numbers 17 to 21, to the extent indicated on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Queen Street, Elms Avenue, Cannon Road, High Street and George Street, and vice versa.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [UK Power Networks Permit KZ50043594848], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
