ELLINGTON ROAD, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

For the safety of the public and workforce during demolition of a property, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit parking on part of Ellington Road, Ramsgate.

Waiting and loading will be prohibited at all times on both sides of Ellington Road, from a point level with the eastern boundary of 91 extending westwards to the western boundary of number 101.

The actual extent will be clearly indicated by No Waiting signs and cones placed on site.

This applies from Friday 12 February 2021 for an estimated period of up to 6 weeks.

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.

This Order over-rides any existing parking entitlements and restrictions that apply to the section of Ellington Road, Ramsgate defined above.

There will be a need for further parking restrictions and a road closure during the construction phase, which is currently scheduled for April, to be confirmed nearer the time.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
