TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Elms Avenue, Ramsgate will be closed to through traffic, on or after 14th May 2020 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Queen Street up to the old Job Centre building.

The alternative route is via Carlton Road, Marlborough Road, Vale Square and West Cliff Road.

It is planned that the road will be closed for the duration.

This closure is necessary to enable urgent carriageway repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
