Foads Hill, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow level crossing inspection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Foads Hill, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 23:45 hours on 6th October 2022, with estimated completion by 05:00 hours 7th October 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL870ACR-84-04-061022A-01 - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Foads Hill will be closed for a distance approximately 20 metres either side of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while level crossing inspection works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Foads Hill, Cliffs End Road, Sandwich Road, Lord Of The Manor Roundabout, A256 Canterbury Road West, Canterbury Road West, and vice versa.

The footway will be closed to pedestrians during this closure, and a taxi service will be provided for pedestrians who need to travel through the closure.
