**GRANGE ROAD, RAMSGATE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Grange Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 12 April 2021 for up to 3 days.

Grange Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 62, to the actual shown, with no through access between the junctions with South Eastern Road and Mays Road.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A254 London Road, A255 Nethercourt Hill, High Street St Lawrence and Ellington Place back to Grange Road.

Local access to the remainder of Grange Road continues from either direction up to where the road is closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
