**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2023**

To allow resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily impose a mandatory 30MPH speed limit on part of A256 Haine Road & B2050 Manston Road.

The speed restriction is planned from 5th June 2023, with estimated completion by 1st December 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE27876956942-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The speed limit for A256 Haine Road will be between Lord of Manor Roundabout and Spratling Lane. The speed limit for B2050 Manston Road will be between the junctions of Greensole Lane and Meridian Close. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The speed restriction is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing resurfacing works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Kent County Council.
