



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**HAINES ROAD, RAMSGATE**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

**To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Haines Road, Ramsgate.**

**A closure is currently planned for Monday 14 June 2021 for up to 3 days.**

**Haines Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Stone Cottage, with no through access between the junctions with A256 New Haines Road.**

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via A256 New Haines Road.**

**Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.**

**The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.**
