A256 HAINE ROAD, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of A256 Haine Road, Ramsgate.

Overnight closures are planned from Thursday 17 September 2020 for up to 7 weekday nights, between 20:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

A256 Haine Road will be closed at its northern (Westwood) end, between the junctions with A256 New Haine Road and A254 Margate Road.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via A256 New Haine Road, New Cross Road, A254 Margate Road

Access to Westwood Cross Shopping Centre will be maintained via Antolin Way.

Star Lane Link and Nash Road will be closed at their junctions with Haine Road, and can be accessed via A254 Margate Road and Star Lane.
