Harbour Street, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow kerb works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Harbour Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 6th September 2021, with estimated completion by 7th September 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40112404796-2 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

Harbour Street will be closed in the vicinity of the junction with Albion Hill, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while kerb works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Harbour Parade, York Street, Queen Street and vice versa.

There will be a suspension of the one way system on Queen Street to facilitate this diversion.
