**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY)  
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Harbour Street, Ramsgate. The one-way order will be suspended on Harbour Street and Queen Street to allow access.

A closure is planned from 11th July 2022, with estimated completion by 15th July 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE05037994876-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Harbour Street will be closed outside number 20-24, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility works are undertaken by Water Supply Surveys Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Harbour Street, B2054 Harbour Parade, York Street, and Queen Street.
