TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Harbour Street, Ramsgate will be closed to through traffic, on or after 17th May 2021 for up to 9 days.

The road will be closed at the junctions of Albion Hill and Queen Street.

**The alternative route is via Harbour Parade, York Street and Queen Street.
The one-way order of Queen Street will be suspended for the duration of the works.**

Harbour Street and Queen Street will remain a pedestrianised zone between the hours of 10:00 and 17:00.

It is planned that the road will be closed for the duration of the works.

This closure is necessary to enable an urgent connection for customer without service to be carried out by SGN.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
