HARBOUR STREET, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Harbour Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from Monday 18 January 2021 for an estimated period of up to 3 days.

Harbour Street will be closed in the general vicinity of numbers 19-21, to the actual extent indicated on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via B2054 Madeira Walk, Wellington Crescent, Plains of Waterloo and King Street.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Harbour Street shall be suspended, to allow any essential access / exit up to where the road is closed.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of King Street shall be suspended between the junctions Broad Street and Harbour Street to allow its use for the diversion.

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network - [Southern Water Permit LQ001SWAT10947281], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
