**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow new water main connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Harbour Street, Ramsgate. The one-way Order on Harbour Street will be suspended for its entire length to allow access. The one-way Order on King Street will be suspended between High Street and Broad Street to allow access.

A closure is planned from 3rd October 2022, with estimated completion by 13th October 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE05037994876-02 & GE05059309582-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Harbour Street will be closed between number 20 and number 27, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new water main connection works are undertaken by Water Supply Surveys Limited.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via B2054 Madeira Walk, B2054 Wellington Crescent, Plains Of Waterloo and King Street.
