TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Hardres Street, Ramsgate will be closed to through traffic on 7th May 2020 for up to 1 day.

The road will be closed at the junctions of High Street and Staffordshire Street.

The alternative route is via Boundary Road, King Street and Brunswick Street.

It is planned that the road will be closed for the duration of the works.

This closure is necessary to enable urgent carriageway repairs to be carried out by Kent County Council.

No Waiting will be required on both sides of the road, for the duration of the works.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
