A299 HENGIST WAY, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to install and move temporary barriers in connection with the construction of an access road to the new Thanet Parkway railway station, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit westbound traffic on part of A299 Hengist Way, Ramsgate.

Overnight closures are planned for the nights of Sunday 14 March 2021 and Wednesday 24 March 2021.

Closures are from 19:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

A299 Hengist Way will be closed westbound (London-bound) only from Lord of the Manor Roundabout to Sevenscore Roundabout

The alternative route for westbound traffic is via A256 Haine Road, New Haine Road, Haine Road, A254 Margate Road, Ramsgate Road, B2052 College Road, Hartsdown Road, George V Avenue, A28 Canterbury Road, A299 Thanet Way and A299 Canterbury Road West back to Hengist Way.

Eastbound traffic is unaffected.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions.
