(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

To allow fibre works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hertford Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 3rd April 2023, with estimated completion by 7th April 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC005WDMML30N01-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Hertford Street will be closed between the junctions of Albert Street and West Cliff Road, between the hours of 09:30 and 15:30 only. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing fibre works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Hertford Street, Albert Street, Liverpool Lawn, Adelaide Garden, Prospect Terrace, Nelson Crescent, Addington Street, The Broadway, West Cliff Road and vice versa.
