(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow utility works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of High Street, Ramsgate. The one-way Order will be suspended to allow access.

A closure is planned from 9th May 2022, with estimated completion by 13th May 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT11752953-03 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

High Street will be closed between numbers 42 and 48, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The road will be open for pedestrian access.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while utility works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via High Street, King Street, Broad Street, and Church Hill.
