



KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
HIGH STREET, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of High Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Wednesday 13 October 2021, with estimated completion by 15 October 2021.

High Street will be closed between the junctions with Church Hill and Meeting Street, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative routes for through traffic are as follows
Eastbound (i.e. towards Harbour) is via Chapel Place, Elms Avenue, Queen Street, Effingham Street and George Street
Westbound via Hardres Street, Broad Street and Church Hill

Local access to the remainder of High Street continues from either direction up to where the road is closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
