HIGH STREET, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of High Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 26 October 2020, with estimated completion by 28 October 2020.

High Street will be closed in the general vicinity of number 66, with no through access between the junctions with Meeting Street and George Street.

The alternative routes for through traffic are:

Eastbound via Chatham Street, A255 Boundary Road, King Street and Broad Street

Westbound via Hardres Street, A255 Boundary Road and Chatham Street

Restricted alternative routes for light traffic only are:

Eastbound via Meeting Street and George Street

Westbound via Hardres Street, Broad Street and Church Hill

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [Southern Water Permit LQ001SWAT10783207], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
