



**KENT COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**HIGH STREET, RAMSGATE**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2021**

**To allow works to be carried out to provide new electricity and water supplies, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of High Street, Ramsgate.**

**A closure is currently planned from Monday 18 October 2021, with estimated completion by 22 October 2021.**

**High Street will be closed between the junctions with Turner Street and Hardres Street, to the actual extent shown on site.**

**The alternative route for through traffic is via King Street, Broad Street, Hardres Street, A255 Boundary Road, Chatham Place and Chatham Street back to High Street.**

**The One-way Traffic Order in respect of High Street will be suspended between the junctions with Turner Street and Hardres Street, to allow limited essential access / exit up to where the road is closed.**

**Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.**

**The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.**
