**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

To allow wall repair works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Honeysuckle Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 14th November 2022, with estimated completion by 16th December 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE10047175244-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Honeysuckle Road will be closed at the side of number 31 Honeysuckle Inn, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while wall repair works are undertaken by WW Martin Ltd.

Access for through traffic will not be maintained due to the narrow carriageway width, however there is an alternative route for residents from the closure points via Honeysuckle Road, A255 Hereson Road, Thanet Road, Dumpton Park Drive and vice versa.
