TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that King Street, Ramsgate will be closed to through traffic, on or after 15th November 2021 for up to 5 days.

The road will be closed outside number 52.

The alternative route is via Plains of Waterloo, B2054 Wellington Crescent, Harbour Parade, Leopold Street, Queen Street, Effingham Street, George Street, High Street and Hardres Street.

It is planned that the road will be closed between for the duration of the works.

This closure is necessary to enable repairs to leaking water pipes in the carriageway, carried out by Southern Water.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
