**King Street, Ramsgate**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**  
**THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**TEMPORARY ORDER 2023**

To allow water works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of King Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 17th July 2023, with estimated completion by 21st July 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT11617805-02 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

King Street will be closed between the junctions of B2054 Victoria Road and Plains of Waterloo. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing water works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via King Street, B2054 Victoria Road, B2054 Victoria Parade, B2054 Wellington Crescent, Plains Of Waterloo and vice versa.
