KING STREET, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER JUNE 2020

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new gas supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of King Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 22 June 2020 with estimated completion by 26 June 2020.

King Street will be closed in the general vicinity of number 34, with no through access between the junctions with Brunswick Street and Broad Street.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Brunswick Street, Turner Street and Broad Street

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of King Street will be suspended when the relevant signs are covered or removed, to allow essential access / exit from either direction up to where the road is closed.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Broad Street will be suspended between the junctions with Turner Street and King Street to allow its use for the diversion.

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.
