KING STREET, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020
T1131C

To allow various works to be safely carried out in connection with the construction of new dwellings, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of King Street, Ramsgate.

A number of 3-day closures will be required over a six-month period, followed by a 2-week closure currently planned for June 2020.

The dates of closures will be signposted on site and notified locally.

The first closure is planned from Wednesday 26 February 2020 for up to 3 days.

King Street will be closed at and including the junction with Sussex Street, with no access between the junctions with Bright's Place and Artillery Road.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Plains of Waterloo, B2054 Wellington Crescent, Victoria Parade and Victoria Road back to King Street.

Local access to the remainder of King Street continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
