KING STREET, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new gas supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of King Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 27 September 2021, with estimated completion by 1 October 2021.

King Street will be closed between the junctions with Wellesley Court and Brunswick Street, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via King Street, A255 Boundary Road, Chatham Street, High Street, Hardres Street, Staffordshire Street, Turner Street and Brunswick Street.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Brunswick Street will be suspended between the junctions with King Street and Turner Street to allow its use for the above diversion.

Local access to the remainder of King Street continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, the restrictions will need to remain in force at all times.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
