**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & SUSPEND ONE-WAY)  
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2022**

To allow highway works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of King Street, Ramsgate. The one-way Order on Broad Street will be suspended between the junctions of Turner Street and King Street to allow access.

A closure is planned from 5th September 2022, with estimated completion by 9th September 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40143224248-01- Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

King Street will be closed between the junctions of Broad Street and Brunswick Street, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while highway works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Brunswick Street, Turner Street and vice versa.
