LIVERPOOL LAWN, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new electricity supply, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Liverpool Lawn, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from Monday 24 February 2020, with estimated completion by 28 February 2019.

Liverpool Lawn will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with Sion Hill.

Local access to the remainder of Liverpool Lawn and Adelaide Gardens continues from a Queen Street direction.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Sion Hill, Rose Hill, Albert Street, Adelaide Gardens and vice versa.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

There is a chance that the planned dates may change, and updated information can be found on one.network – [UK Power Networks Permit KZ50020233989], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
