B2050 Manston Road, Manston
(TEMPORARY ONE-WAY RESTRICTION)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2023

To allow road works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily impose a one-way restriction on part of B2050 Manston Road, Manston.

The restriction is planned from 14th August 2023, with estimated completion by 17th September 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE27884807054-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

The one-way restriction will be imposed between the junction of Greensole Lane and A256 Haine Road. To the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The restriction is required for the safety of the public and workforce while allowing road works to be carried out, works are undertaken by Walker Construction.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A256 Haine Road, A256 Canterbury Road West, A299 Hengist Way, B2190 Minster Road, B2190 Un-Named Road From Minster Road To Columbus Avenue, B2190 Spitfire Way, B2050 Manston Road East and vice versa.
