MARINA ESPLANADE, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow various works to be carried out in connection with ongoing sea defence works, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Marina Esplanade, Ramsgate.

The section of Marina Esplanade parallel with Granville Marina will be closed at certain times, to the actual extent indicated on site.

A number of daytime closures are planned within the period between 1 November 2020 and the end of January 2021. Closures will be between 1-5 days duration.

Closures will generally be between 07:00 hours and 18:00 hours each day, with night-time closures avoided if at all possible.

All closures will be notified in advance to local residents and signposted on site.

There is no alternative route as such, as the area is a no-through-road.

Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for any residents affected when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
