**MARINA ESPLANADE &
GRANVILLE MARINA, RAMSGATE**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow sea defence works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Marina Esplanade and Granville Marina, Ramsgate.

The main works will be carried out in 2 phases as shown below

PHASE 1 – Granville Marina Promenade will be closed for its entire length, with pedestrians diverted onto a path on the landward side

PHASE 2 – Marina Esplanade will be closed west of Beach Retreat to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Prior to the main closures, there may need to be additional closures to allow the use of machinery.

All closures will be signposted on site in advance and notified to local residents

There is no alternative route as the area is a no-through-road.

Due to the nature of these works, closures may remain in place outside the working hours.

Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for any residents affected when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.

This Order commences from 17 June 2019 and remains in force until the works have been completed, with anticipated completion by 20 September 2019.
