**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

To allow telecoms ducting and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Meeting Street and Guildford Lawn, Ramsgate.

Phased closures are planned from Monday 7 June 2021, with anticipated completion by 20 June 2021.

Meeting Street and Guildford Lawn will be closed in turn, starting with Guildford Lawn, with only one road closed at any one time.

**GUILDFORD LAWN** will be closed at its western end, with access to the remainder of the road continuing from George Street direction.

**MEETING STREET** will then be closed at the junction with George Street.

Access to the remainder of Meeting Street, including the car park, continues via its alternative junction with High Street.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the roads outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
