Melbourne Avenue, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING & WAITING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow construction works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic and waiting on part of Melbourne Avenue, Ramsgate.

The restrictions are planned from 21st March 2022, with estimated completion by 21st September 2023, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE10004491337-01 - WW Martin Limited). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

A temporary mandatory no waiting restriction will be imposed from 21st March 2022, with estimated completion by 21st September 2023, between the entrance to Copperfields and the junction of Ringold Avenue, as clearly indicated by temporary double yellow lines.

Melbourne Avenue will be closed from 4th April 2022, with estimated completion by 26th June 2022, between the entrance to Copperfields and the junction of Princess Margaret Avenue, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while construction works are undertaken by WW Martin Limited.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Melbourne Avenue, St Johns Avenue, St Johns Crescent, Princess Margaret Avenue, and vice versa.
