B2014 NEWINGTON ROAD, RAMSGATE

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow essential carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2014 Newington Road, Ramsgate.

Overnight closures are planned from Tuesday 2 March 2021 for up to 5 weekday nights, from 19:00 hours through until approximately 05:00 hours each night.

B2014 NEWINGTON ROAD will be closed in sections between the junctions with B2050 Manston Road and Princes Avenue, to the actual extent indicated at any time.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A255 High Street St Lawrence, Park Road, Shah Place and A254 Margate Road back to Newington Road, and *vice versa*.

WHITEHALL ROAD will be closed at the junction with B2014 Newington Road, with access continuing from an eastern (Margate Road) direction

BUSH AVENUE will be closed at the junction with Newington Road, with access continuing from Princess Margaret Avenue/Melbourne Avenue Roundabout

Queens Avenue and Kings Avenue will be closed at their junctions with Newington Road, with access continuing from St James Avenue

Beaufort Avenue, Cheriton Avenue, Fairlight Avenue, Marden Avenue and Telham Avenue will be closed at their junctions with B2014 Newington Road at certain times as the works progress

Personnel will be on site to allow managed access for residents when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including adverse weather conditions and the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [Kent County Council Permit GE70573217566], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
