**B2014 NEWINGTON ROAD, RAMSGATE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2020**

To allow gas mains replacement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of B2014 Newington Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 26 October 2020, with estimated completion by 1 November 2020.

Newington Road will be closed in the general vicinity of the bridge over the railway line, to the actual extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for all through traffic is via B2014 Newington Road, B2050 Manston Road, A256 Haine Road, New Haine Road, New Cross Road and A254 Margate Road.

Local access to the remainder of Newington Road continues from either direction up to where the road is closed, but there will be no through access during these works.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
