TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Nixon Avenue, Ramsgate has been closed to through traffic, on or after 27th March 2023 for up to 11 days.

The road is closed outside 57.

The alternative route is via Nixon Avenue, Whitehall Road, B2014 Newington Road, Allenby Road and Nixon Avenue.

This closure is necessary to enable a corroded main replacement to be carried out by SGN.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 21 days.
