TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Norman Road, Ramsgate will be closed to through traffic, on or after 25 March 2020 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed between the junctions of Queen Bertha Road and St Lawrence Avenue.

The alternative route is via St Lawrence Avenue, London Road, St Mildreds Road and vice versa.

Kent County Council gives notice that waiting will be prohibited at all times on Norman Road, Ramsgate, from 25 March 2020 for up to 2 days.

This applies to both sides of Norman Road, Ramsgate, between the junctions of Queen Bertha Road and St Lawrence Avenue.

The Notice has the effect of over-riding any existing parking entitlements and restrictions that apply to the sections of road defined above.

The closure is necessary to enable Kent County Council to carry out works to carriageway repairs.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
