Northwood Road, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2022

To allow carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Northwood Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned between 19:00 hours and 05:00 hours from 19th August 2022 (excluding weekends), with estimated completion by 27th August 2022, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70593021797-01 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Northwood Road will be closed for the entire length.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while carriageway resurfacing works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A254 Margate Road, A254 Pearce Signs Roundabout, A256 Westwood Road and vice versa.
