PARAGON STREET, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2019

To allow sewer repair works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Paragon Street, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from Monday 8 July 2019, with estimated completion by 12 July 2019.

Paragon Street will be closed between the junctions with Paragon Place and B2054 Paragon

The alternative route for is via Addington Street, West Cliff Road, Royal Road and B2054 Paragon.

The One-way Traffic Order in respect of Paragon Street will be suspended to allow limited essential access / exit from either direction.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.
