Pegwell Road, Ramsgate
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow for new utility connection works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Pegwell Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is planned from 6th December 2021, with estimated completion by 8th December 2021, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ002SWAT11553848-02 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signs showing and/or displayed on [One.Network](#)

Pegwell Road will be closed in the vicinity of number 33, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while new utility connection works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Goodwin Road, Minster Road, St Lawrence Avenue, Pegwell Road and vice versa.
