**PEGWELL ROAD & DOWNS ROAD,
RAMSGATE**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow telecoms ducting and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Pegwell Road and Downs Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 15 February 2021 for up to 3 days.

PEGWELL ROAD will be closed in the general vicinity of the Chilton Tavern (south of the junction with Downs Road / Chilton Lane) to the extent shown on site

Local access to the remainder of Pegwell Road Ramsgate continues from an eastern (B2054 London Road) direction

The alternative route for through traffic is via Chilton Lane and B5054 London Road

DOWNS ROAD will be closed westbound only, at the junction with Pegwell Road / Chilton Lane

Westbound access to Pegwell Road, Chilton Lane and Chalk Hill is via Minster Road, B2054 London Road and Chilton Lane

Access to the remainder of Downs Road continues from an eastern direction, and eastbound traffic is unaffected.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the roads outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [BT Openreach Permit BC311D05687003-01], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
