TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF DRIVING

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (2)

Kent County Council gives notice that Percy Road, Ramsgate will be closed to through traffic, on or after 30 March 2020 for up to 2 days.

The road will be closed between the junctions of St Lukes Avenue and Margate Road.

The alternative route is via Margate Road, Hollincondane Road and St Lukes Avenue.

Kent County Council gives notice that waiting will be prohibited at all times on Percy Road, Ramsgate, from 30 March 2020 for up to 2 days.

This applies to both sides of Percy Road, Ramsgate, between the junctions of St Lukes Avenue and Margate Road.

The Notice has the effect of over-riding any existing parking entitlements and restrictions that apply to the sections of road defined above.

The closure is necessary to enable Kent County Council to carry out carriageway repairs.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
