



KENT COUNTY COUNCIL
PICTON ROAD, RAMSGATE
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow excavation works to be carried out to repair a sewer, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Picton Road, Ramsgate.

A closure is currently planned from Tuesday 31 August 2021, with estimated completion by 10 September 2021.

Picton Road will be closed in the general vicinity of number 10, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Crescent Road, South Eastern Road and Ellington Road.

Local access to the remainder of Picton Road continues from either direction up to where the road is closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
